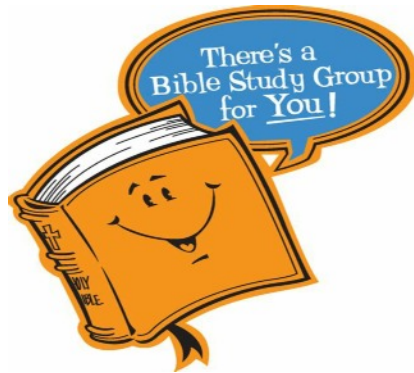
Please submit your ideas for a scarecrow as soon as possible. Remember the scarecrow must include recycled or reused items. We'll pick one or maybe two to build.
