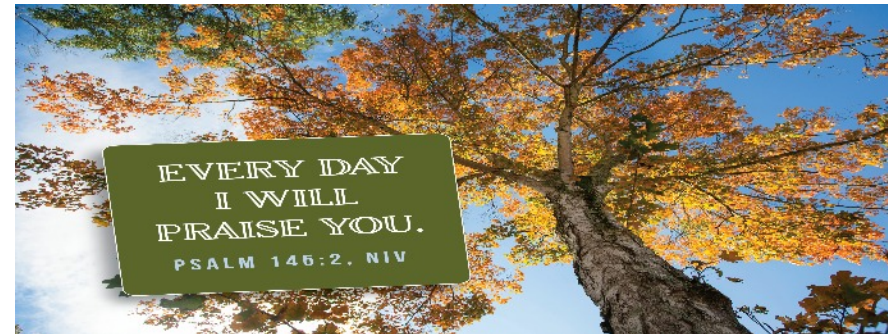
Our Church Council Meetings are open to all who desire to know and learn more about our church here at HOMER UMC. You don't even have to hold a position on a committee to come.
