Visitors are always welcome. *Spouses are welcome to attend our December meeting along with their husbands.*

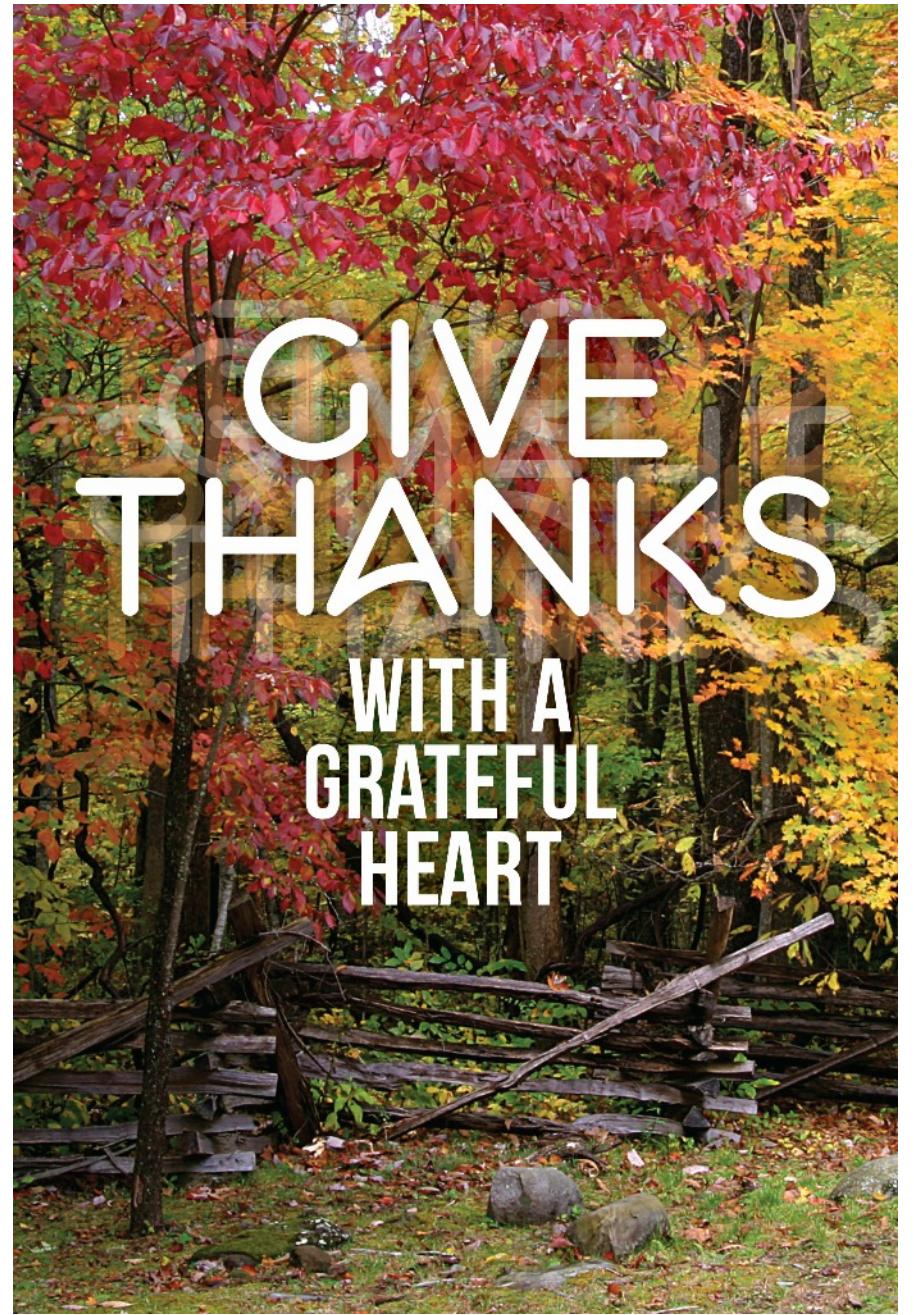
